Goods Folks of York County is a group of residents and businesses that support local charities.

Each December, Good Folks holds a special luncheon to raise funds for organizations that demonstrate a need not covered by normal operating income or expense. Gifts have ranged from \$20,000 to \$75,000, and have gone toward projects that serve our youth or address critical needs focused on health, shelter or food.
